A suitable prize will be presented to the winning teams and a commemorative shield at one of our network events .

It is our increasing use of energy supplied primarily by fossil fuels that is primarily responsible for the increasing emissions of greenhouse gases and the subsequent global warming.

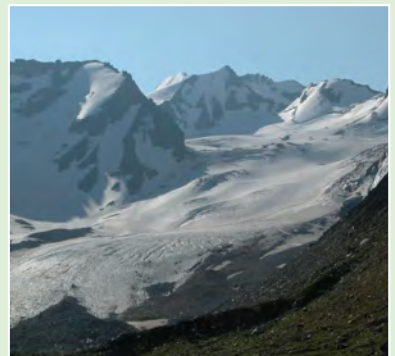


Cause and effect
